An impressive addition to the existing medical facility in the North Houston area of Texas has opened its doors after completing phase one of a two phase construction effort. The second phase is scheduled to open in February of 2006. The second phase will bring the room total of private treatment rooms up to 47, doubling the current emergency capacity.
